Since then, the empty warehouse has been transformed into our new home. The team of builders, painters, an electrician, and plumbers, have built two lofts for storage of costumes, props and a tech deck. There is a new bathroom, kitchen and office space. There is space for flats, chairs and tools and a special place of Terry's printing projects.

We hope to have final occupancy approval from the city very soon. In the meantime, the old space is being deconstructed and the move has started.

The costume team has been incredibly busy culling, packing and planning for the upcoming sale on the 22<sup>nd</sup>.
